

## **Booth painter/hanger**

The booth painter/hanger is responsible for spraying wet paint onto various formed sheet metal parts. The painter is also responsible for hanging these parts to be painted and dried as required.

### **Position Responsibilities**

- Loads formed sheet metal parts onto the belt using metal hooks
- Applies enamel spray paint using a spray gun in a paint booth
- QC's parts as their team member finishes painting
- Performs touch up painting as required
- Completes work orders according to scheduling needs

### **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**

- Must be able to stand in one spot for 8 hours with a full paint suit on
- Must be able to hold a 3 pound spray gun for 4-8 hours
- Must be able to lift at least 50 pounds
- Ability to pay attention to detail in order to spot run offs, uneven paint jobs, and wet paint.
- Ability to communicate with others effectively
- Have reliable transportation
