- Be actively engaged in Lean manufacturing and continuous improvement efforts.
- Be on-time for every scheduled shift - reliable attendance is a must!

- Experience reading and interpreting work orders and build programs.
- Experience using specialized measuring tools like digital calipers and height gauges.
